In The Ear (ITE) 	• Rechargeable available in some models • Bluetooth available in some models • Suitable for moderate to severe hearing loss • Size dependent on required power, and the shape and size of the ear canal.	
Assistive listening devices 	Assistive listening devices are recommended for use alongside your hearing aids. For example, TV connectors stream the sound from your television directly to your hearing aids. Additional microphones can help in noisier environments, especially for those with more severe hearing loss.
